MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING (MoU)

BETWEEN

STATE UNIVERSITY OF BANGLADESH (SUB), DHAKA, BANGLADESH

AND

COLLEGE OF ENGINEERING, GYEONGSANG NATIONAL UNIVERSITY (GNU),
REPUBLIC OF KOREA

1. PREAMBLE

1.1. Recognizing the mutual benefits through a cooperative program promoting scholarly activities and international understanding between SUB and GNU enter into this MoU on the terms set out below. Both universities will share a common mission to provide the highest quality of education, and will establish a collaborative relationship to strengthen educational, cultural, and scientific ties.

2. PURPOSE

2.1. The purpose of this MoU is to provide a framework by which both universities may in future undertake joint activities together, which may include:

- (a) development of collaborative research works;
- (b) organisation of joint academic and scientific activities, such as courses, conferences, seminars, symposia or lectures;
- (c) exchange of academic staff for teaching and research activities;
- (d) encourage PhD/HDR students to undertake short term study or participate in research programs and projects at respective host institution;
- (e) Exchange of online database and journal facilities;
- (f) Joint supervision of the graduate students for higher degrees;
- (g) Providing the services of the existing sophisticated inter laboratories facilities of both institutions to carry out joint research programmes with the view to achieving excellence and outstanding results in the respective research fields;



(h) exchange of publications and other information of common interest; and

(i) any other collaborative activities as mutually agreed in writing between the two institutions.

2.2. Cooperative projects under this MoU may include any of the academic disciplines of the institutions.

3. STATUS

3.1. This Memorandum does not create any legally binding obligations or rights between two parties.

3.2. Any specific arrangements undertaken by the institutions will be documented in legally binding agreements.

4. FINANCIAL ARRANGEMENT

4.1. Within the limits of regulations in each organization, the parties agreed to find the financial means necessary to reach the above-mentioned objectives. The expenses will be jointly identified and managed by mutual discussion.

5. TERM OF THIS MEMORANDUM

5.1. This Memorandum commences on the date specified on the last page of this document and remains in effect for a period of FIVE years from commencement.

5.2. The parties may extend or renew this MoU by mutual agreement.

5.3. Either party may terminate this MoU at any time by notifying the other party at least six (6) months in advance of the proposed date of termination.

5.4. Termination or expiry of this Memorandum does not affect any legally binding arrangements in effect or continuing following termination or expiry of this Memorandum.

6. JOINT ACTIVITIES

6.1. Either party may initiate proposals for activities at any time and submit them to the other party for consideration. If the parties agree to implement any proposal, then they will enter
